At **Bankingly** ("Bankingly", "we", "us" or "our"), we use cookies and similar technologies on the website <u>www.bankingly.com</u> to ensure its proper functioning, analyze site usage and improve the user experience.

This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, which types we use and how you can manage them.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device (computer, tablet or mobile phone) when you visit a website. They allow the website to function properly and help collect information about your browsing activity.

2. Types of cookies we use

On **bankingly.com**, we use the following categories of cookies:

a) Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for the website to function and cannot be disabled. They enable core functionalities such as secure navigation and proper site operation.

b) Analytics or performance cookies

These cookies allow us to collect aggregated and anonymous information about how users interact with the website (for example, pages visited, time spent on the site, or site performance). This information is used solely for statistical purposes and continuous improvement.

These cookies are only activated if the user accepts them through the cookie banner.

3. Third-party cookies

Some cookies may be provided by third parties that offer analytics or measurement services. These third parties may process the collected information in accordance with their own privacy policies.

4. Acceptance or rejection of cookies

When accessing bankingly.com, a cookie banner is displayed allowing users to accept or reject the use of non-essential cookies.

- If you accept, analytics cookies will be enabled.
- If you reject, only strictly necessary cookies will be used.

At this time, individual cookie configuration options are not available on the website.

5. Managing cookies through your browser

In addition to the options provided by the cookie banner, you can manage or delete cookies through your browser settings. Please note that disabling all cookies may affect the functionality of the website.
